WHAT WE DO...

The main focus of the centre is to assist the vulnerable children and those who are also orphans.

The children and youth are assisted on how to socialize in the community and learn activities of daily living skills, orientation and mobility skills. Parents are trained how to communicate with their children and youth with disabilities and guidance counseling are given to both the children and the family members.

WHERE WE ARE...

Chisombezi Deafblind is in the Southern Region of Malawi in Chiradzulu District, Mkwamba Village, T/A Likoswe. It is in a rural setting. These children are both deaf and blind plus mental challenges to know about themselves. Chisombezi deafblind is located along the road leading to the Catholic University of Malawi and St. Joseph Hospital.
